

Minutes for the March 3, 2007 Foretravel Mid-South Spring Rally

President Jack Frey #13006 called the business meeting of the Mid-South Spring Rally at Montgomery, Texas to order on March 3, 2007.

The President also recognized our Foretravel staff member Merlin Neel #11213 and Foretravel Company owners Lyle and Nell Reed and our present International President and First Lady Bob and Debra Best.

The treasurer's report was read and a motion was made by Joseph (Jack) Le Blanc #16034 to accept the report. Smokey Griggs #7117 seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The audit committee submitted their report. The committee members are as follows: Roy Le Tourneau #10712, Bill Jennings #7828 and Bobby Joe Lee #7949.

The President read the audit committee report since the committee could not attend the Rally.

After a discussion, Larry Teague #9342 moved we accept the audit report as read providing the president explains the small discrepancy between the audit report and the financial report at a later date. Rich Holmer #15456 seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The President announced that we now have a Web page for our Mid-south club run by Rich Holmer #15456. He asked that club member please turn in their e-mail addresses on the sign up sheet and send in news and pictures to Rich Holmer for our Web page.

The President announced that the next "Friends" Rally would be held at Nacogdoches, TX on May 17th-19th. Our Fall Rally will be October 18-21. The Club had a choice of having it in Hot Springs, Arkansas or Kerrville, TX. The Club voted to have the Fall Rally in Kerrville, TX.

The Grand Vention Date is October 22nd. It is to be held in the Dallas/Fort Worth Metro-Plax, which is an easy drive from Kerrville.

The President gave a plea for Wagon Masters. He has two assistant Wagon Masters Rich and Francille Holmer #15456 and Pete and Jerry Wright #16147, who have volunteered to help with the Kerrville, Tx Rally but we need a head Wagon Master. He asks all the members who have been Wagon Masters to stand. Then he pointed to the entire membership who were seated and told the Holmers and the Wrights that they could call on the entire membership who were not standing.

He also asked for volunteers for Wagon Master for Roy Le Tourneau #10712, who sent his regrets that he could not be at this Rally.

However, if such were not available, the Vice President's spouse would be a viable alternate or even the Vice President himself. Paul Welker #15429 seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Larry Teague #9342 moved that the meeting be adjourned. Smokey Greggs # 7117 seconded it. The motion carried and the meeting was adjourned with the singing of "God Bless America".
